Analysis of benzalkonium chloride in sticking plaster

Benzalkonium chloride which was flashed on antiseptic gauze in sticking plaster was analyzed after its extraction from antiseptic gauze. Since Benzalkonium had a longer carbon chain and a basic group, a silica C1 column Finepak SIL C1 in which trimethyl monochloro silica groups are chemically bonded on silica gel was used.
